

Session 1

Week No. 1: June 26 - June 30, 2017

Nature Theme: Nature walks and exploration of the beautiful grounds of Snug Harbor Cultural Center. Visits to the Butterfly Garden, the White Garden, the Secret Garden and various other sites. Children will create and decorate their own visors to wear throughout the summer.

Week No. 2: July 3 - July 7, 2017

Nature Theme: Nature walks and exploration of the beautiful grounds of Snug Harbor Cultural Center continues. Children will receive their own magnifying glasses and tweezers. They will collect leaves and insects to place in the bug jars that each child will decorate.

Week No. 3: July 10 - July 14, 2017

Cooking Theme: Children will learn about the food pyramid and healthy eating. Each child will create his/her own apron that they will decorate. Children will be preparing Jello for snack.

Week No. 4: July 17 - July 21, 2017

Cooking Theme: Cooking theme continues this week. Children will be preparing fruit salad for snack and will make their own Fruit Loop Necklaces.

Week No. 1: July 24 - July 28, 2017

Music/Dance and Movement Theme: Children will be involved in many fun activities indoors and outdoors. Activities will include freeze dance, twister, musical chairs and other indoor and outdoor games. Children will learn about music and create their own instruments.

Art Theme: Children will be learning about different artists and will explore many types of media. Each child will create their own masterpiece through painting and collage.

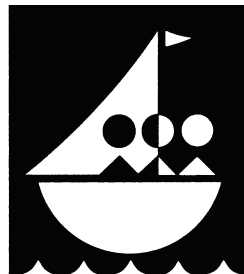
Week No. 3: August 7 - August 11, 2017

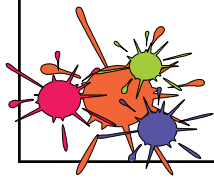

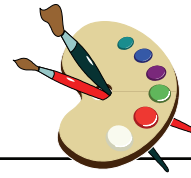
